DAILY PRACTICE LOG EXAMPLE

- Scales: G major, 3 octaves (intonation focus)
- Etude: Kreutzer #9 (slow, dotted rhythms)
 - Mendelssohn concerto, 2nd mvt (phrasing, bow control)
- Sight reading: Haydn quartet, 1 page
- ◆ Reflection: Shift to 5th position smoother today
- ◆ Challenge: Struggled with rhythm in Kreutzer
